On Sep 17 2022, along with Chandra Ji, Usha Ji & family we had a chance to visit one of the largest man-made lake of Bangalore – **Jakkur Lake located in the north eastern part of Bengaluru.**

It is reported that among the 209 species of birds found at the lake, pelicans, painted storks, Cormorants, parakeets, owls are few of them. Since Jakkur Lake is very rich in Biodiversity there is a healthy growth of mosses, reeds and cattails. Small animals such as snails, worms, frogs, and dragonflies co-exist along with water lilies and water hyacinths. Water bugs, beetles, and spiders glide across the surface.
