
When there is a knock on your door, it is an opportunity to rise up from the floor, grab it and run towards the shore, else you will miss the boat that's going to build your fortune for sure.

- A corporate discount in the overall bill offered by the hospital at the time of discharge
- Lower premium for Corporate policy compared to Individual policy
- Full support from Infocareer Corporate teams in providing policy details and no need for individual to search around for documentation.


